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Guardian Participation Protocols

Dear Barksdale Guardians,

You have a very important role in which each guardian plays in the Barksdale Labradoodle Program. Each one of you are responsible for the health and well-being of your Barksdale Guardian. I would like to take this opportunity to remind you of the Barksdale Guardian Health Protocol. These things are part of the requirements you as a guardian are responsible for maintaining on your dood.

The guardian should inform their Veterinarian of Barksdale's Protocol. It is the guardian's responsibility to also inform their Vet that Barksdale's Guardian Coordinator will communicate with them regarding Guardian records. Only Veterinarians approved by Barksdale are authorized to perform services for the BK ALd. We at Barksdale look forward to having a harmonious relationship between BK's Vet team and our Guardian's Vets.

Barksdale's Guardian Coordinator will communicate with your Vet to assure full knowledge of the BK Breeder's status i.e. flow of information both ways—Your Vet will receive BK's records and BK's Veterinary team will receive your Vet's records.

- 1) Semiannual negative fecal tests. Notify Barksdale Guardian Coordinator when these take place.
- 2) Proheart 6 (or 12) or Heartguard Plus. Notify Barksdale Guardian Coordinator of which your dood takes and the schedule.
- 3) ID Tags and Rabies Tags are required on your dood's collars at all times.
- 4) Bravecto or Nexgard for flea and tick control. Notify Guardian Coordinator of which your dood is taking and the schedule. We strongly recommend quarterly Bravecto for flea and tick control.

We trust each of you with our dood's and thank you for the wonderful love and care that you give to them.
